





Fayette Co. Historical Trail Passport

Geocaching is a great way to get out and experience Fayette Co. This trail is a digital historic treasure hunt. You will need a smartphone or a hand held GPS to search for each of the caches by their GPS coordinates. Thirteen geocaches have been placed in different ares of Fayette County, Ohio. Each of the caches are placed in an area representing a historically significant person, place, or event in Fayette Co.. When you have meet the requirements to log a cache, fill in the date and the necessary code word(s) found on the log sheet, in this passport. All geocaches are officially registered on www.geocaching.com. Participants will need to be registered on www.geocaching.com to receive the coordinates and other cache information. Basic membership registration is free.

If you haven't tried geocaching before, go online to www.geocaching.com

- 1. Register your username. Basic membership is free.
- 2. Pick a place, find the cache and write down your username on the log sheet. Find the code word found on the log sheet of each cache and record it and the date in the passport box that corresponds with that cache GC# & name.
- 3. Record your find on www.geocaching.com.
